



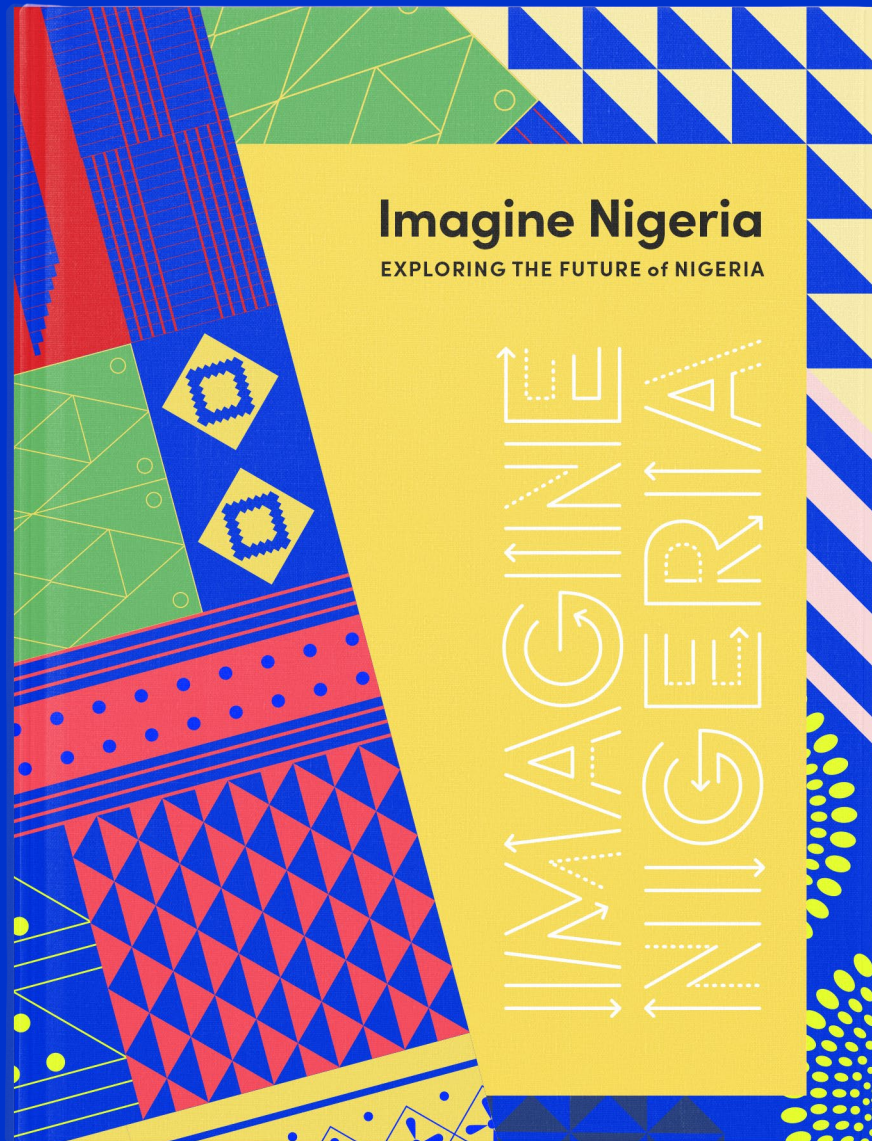

The Imagine Nigeria exercise

Imagine Nigeria was conceived as a multi-stakeholder effort to reflect on the future of Nigeria. initiated in October 2020, involved around 300 people from all regions of Nigeria and abroad in consultations, research, analysis to construction of scenarios on the possibilities of the future for Nigeria.



The reflection phase of the exercise took about nine months and the outputs of the exercise include the main report, “Imagine Nigeria: Exploring the Future of Nigeria”.

The report provides analysis of the context, overview of global trends, alternative scenarios and recommendations to building a desirable future for all Nigerians.

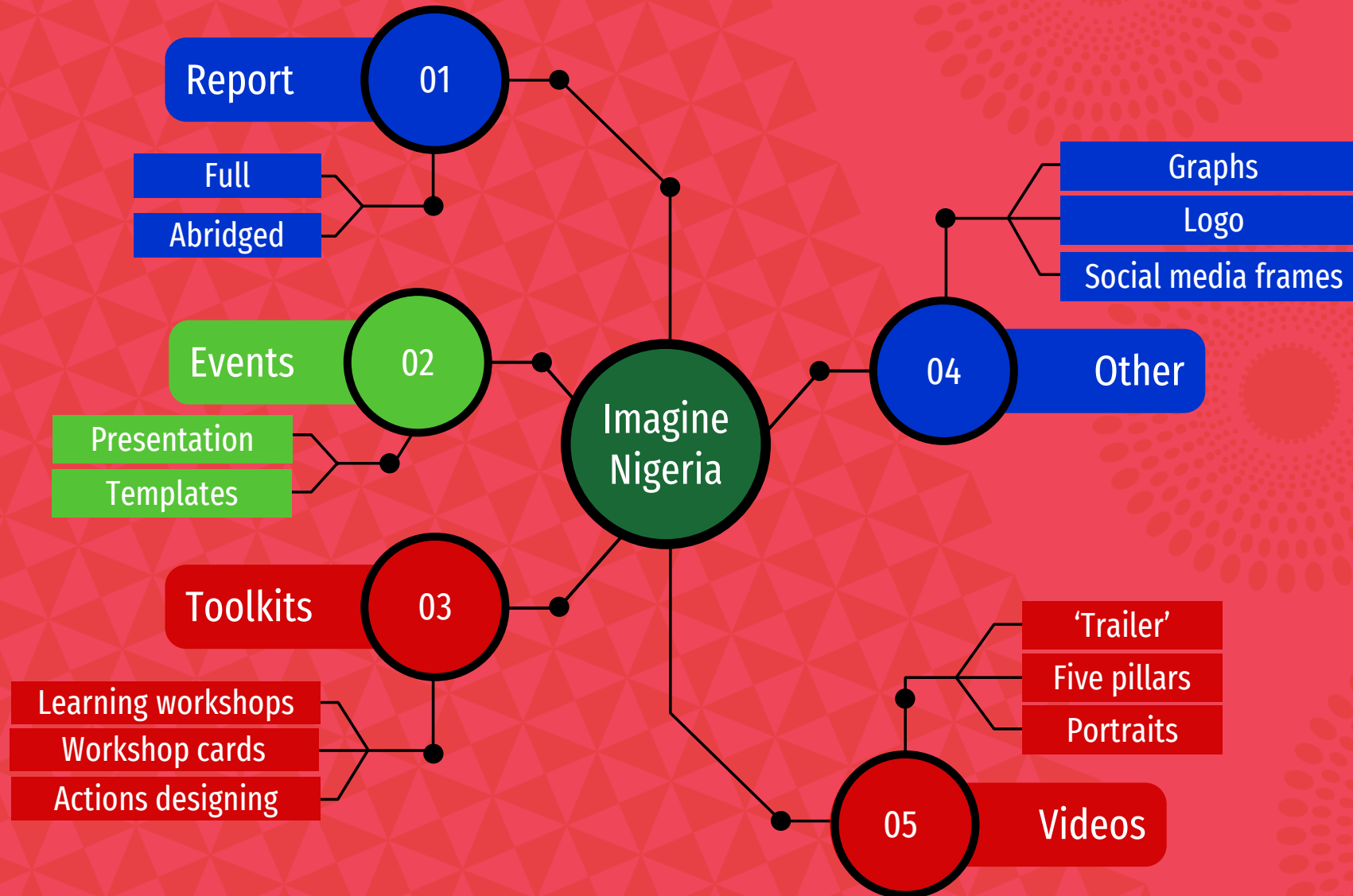
This is just the beginning...

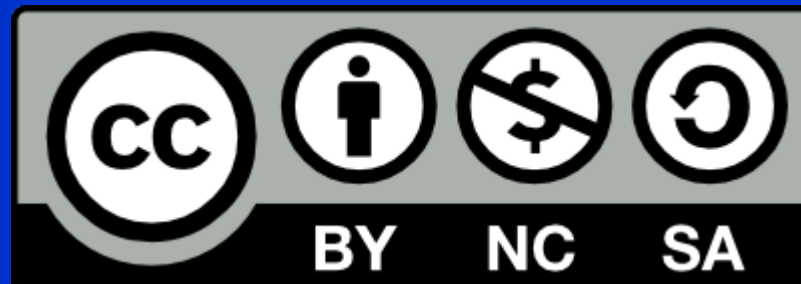
If you are in the private sector, you can use our scenarios in your strategic plan and analyze to which of the transformation pillars your business can contribute the most.
